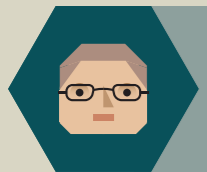

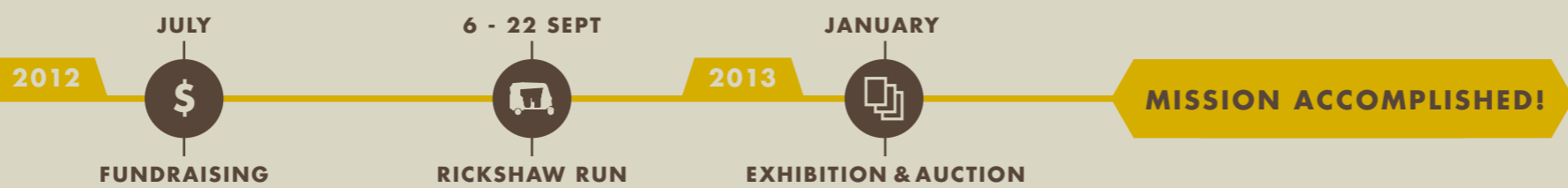

Its huge and growing population is putting a strain on the country's natural resources. Most water sources are contaminated by sewage and agricultural waste.



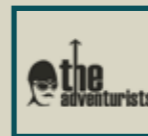
21% COMMUNICABLE DISEASES RELATED TO DIRTY WATER
